2.0 ORDINARY DIPLOMA IN LAW - PARALEGAL STUDIES (NTA 5 - 6)

- a) Holder of Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (ACSEE) with at least one principal pass and one subsidiary and having at least four passes in form four results, excluding religious subjects.
 OR
- b) Holder of a Basic Certificate in Paralegal Work (NTA Level 4) from the Law School of Tanzania or Basic Certificate in Law (NTA Level 4), Police Science, Policing and Security Management, Correctional Science, Law Enforcement from any recognized institution.

OR

- c) Any other equivalent qualifications recognised by the relevant authority.
- Note: All Foreign Secondary School Certificates must have their equivalence from the National Examinations Council of Tanzania.
